How Do You Feel about Lent?

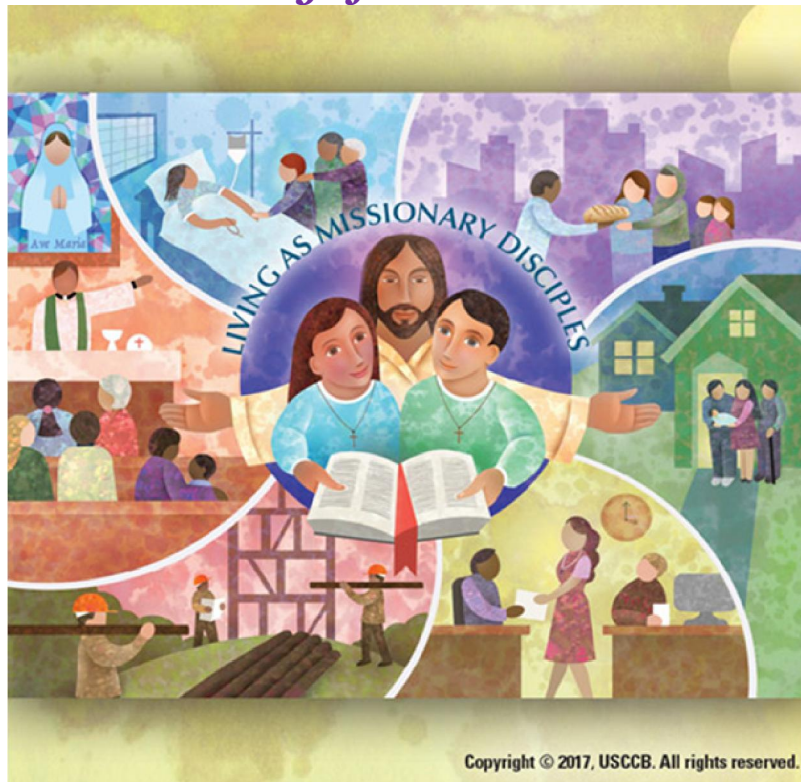
